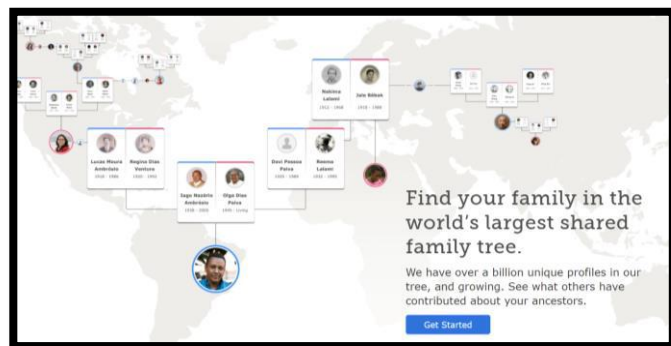

This class will explore the features of the largest website for free genealogical records on the internet: *Familysearch.org*. Supported by the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints, this site includes vast historical records – both domestic and international, the Family Tree, a Research Wiki with tutorials and helps, an opportunity to volunteer in record indexing and more. Featured as a beginner class for those who have not used this site, it will also be useful for those who have had some experience, but want to learn more.

Celia McNay did her first family history project when she was 16 years old for a special church event. She has been doing genealogy, preserving family stories, and searching out relatives ever since. Now with a bachelor's degree in Family History from Brigham Young University and over 30 years of research, Celia is a staff member of the North Bend Family History Center and past president of Eastside Genealogical Society. Although her first love is picking through old documents, Celia also enjoys teaching others about genealogy.
